What is the Status Model?

The HSA graphs in this section represent a status model. These data show the status of 12th, 11th or 10th grade students on meeting the High School Assessment requirement for graduation.

The data show how many students in each of the three grades have currently met the graduation requirement (for all HSA tests) and where they are in meeting that requirement as well as where students are in taking and passing each individual test. The data is broken out for all students and the ten subgroups.

This information should help schools identify which groups of students and how many students need additional opportunities and/or support to meet the HSA graduation requirement.

The graphed data focuses on two different lines of examination:

- 1) where the grade level is in relation to meeting the HSA graduation requirement to achieve a passing score on all content areas tested and
- 2) where the grade level is in relation to taking and passing the individual tests.

Please note that to graduate, students must also meet additional state and local requirements.
