

## Teacher Induction 2014-2015 Regional Follow Up Sessions

The chart which follows on the next page is a summary of the information which we gathered both at the June Academy and in subsequent conversations with individual LEAs. A few details:

- Terry will be in touch with you to provide additional information (i.e. directions to given sites, room capacity, etc.) regarding each of the regional follow up sessions.
- On the chart which follows, you will see the dates which you selected at the Academy. Please remember that you may invite those who attended the Academy, as well as those who did not. Terry will contact you to share the number of slots that will be allocated to each LEA. As we have done with the Academies, we will work to meet your needs, so please be in touch with her if you find you need additional slots or need fewer slots.

  - If even that is prohibitive, please feel free to attend as the Coordinator (or designee) who can implement the train-the-trainer model.
